Trustees' Report 2012/2013

Trustees of the Ranaviru Fund have the pleasure of producing this report for the Financial Year 2012-2013.

A total of £6,283 carried forward from the financial year 2011/2012.

A total of £72 received as donations during this year with an addition of £2 received as bank interest.

During the financial year the Charity has invested £3,118 in 3 different projects. Although the Charity has seen a significant drop of sustainable donations in the UK it receives, £2,000 has been invested to provide medical care for the children who require urgent medical attention.

In this year the Charity has provided a further stock of 100 Socket Gel Liners for the benefit of amputee soldiers of the Sri Lanka Army. The cost of this donation was £998. Ranaviru Fund was able to receive assistance from a well wisher to sponsor the cost of freight of these Gel Liners from London to Colombo.

In addition the Charity has provided 2 Ultrasonic Obstacle detectors for the good use of two visually impaired soldiers at a cost of £120.

At the end of the financial year 2012/2013 a total of £3,239 retained in the Charity's bank account.

Every possible measure has been taken by the Trustees of the charity to minimise the administrative costs and other operational costs of the charity to a minimum. It is our pleasure to state that such costs are nil in this financial year as well.

Charity Trustees would like to thank and extend their warmest gratitude to everyone who supported the charity and its causes in numerous ways.
