Trustees' annual report for the year ended 31 March 2022

The trustees present their report and the accounts for the period ended 31 March 2022.

Objectives, organisation and activities:

Ranaviru Fund is an unincorporated association concerned with the relief of those in need by reason of age, ill health, disability, financial hardship or other disadvantage people in the community. It is a registered charity, number SC041479.

The objectives of the charity are:

To provide medical, rehabilitation, welfare and social assistance for the fallen, missing, disabled and wounded Army, Navy, Air Force, Police and Civil Defence Forces members (hereinafter referred as the "Soldier" or "Soldiers") and their immediate family members in Sri Lanka.

It makes grants, donations, loans, gifts or pensions to individuals and to organisations.

Trustees of the Ranaviru Fund have the pleasure of producing this report for the Financial Year 2021-2022.

A total of £4,562 carried forward from the financial year 2020-2021.

A total of £2,328 received as donations during this year with no bank interest received during this financial year.

During the financial year the charity has invested £1,088 in charitable activities while £50 spent on subscriptions and professional fees.

At the end of the financial year 2021/2022 a total of £5,752 retained in the charity's bank account.

Every possible measure has been taken by the Trustees of the charity to minimise the administrative costs and other operational costs of the charity to a minimum.

Charity Trustees would like to thank and extend their warmest gratitude to everyone who supported the charity and its causes in numerous ways.

Financial assistance for Ms. Himali Dissanayake's eye surgery



Mrs. Dissanayake was waiting for the procedure for a long time due to the lack of financial support and as a result her eye sight was deteriorating at a significant rate. With the assistance of funds provided by Ranaviru Fund her eye surgery was successfully completed.

Financial assistance for pawn relief - Ms D. M. Siriyalatha

D. M. Siriyalatha is a wife of a deceased service personnel. She has three children. Siriyalatha's husband pawned their 2.5-acre paddy land many years ago for Rs. 800,000. The current value of the paddy land is about Rs. 2.5 million. Ranaviru Fund donated £273.46 (LKR 100,000) towards the initial pawn relief of the paddy land.
