

Trustees' Report 2011

Trustees of the Ranaviru Fund have the pleasure of producing this report for the Financial Year 2010-2011.

A total of £4,977 carried forward from the financial year 2009/2010.

A total of £2,222 has been received as donations during this year with an addition of £2 received as interest.

During the financial year the Charity has invested £1,998 in total and of which £998 was spent in the United Kingdom to purchase the Socket Gel Liners for the benefit of amputee war heroes. A further £1,000.00 spent in other welfare projects in Sri Lanka, which summarise below.

Welfare projects in Sri Lanka mainly aim the disabled or wounded war heroes or their immediate family members who need financial & social assistance. Ranaviru Fund has provided financial assistance to complete 2 disabled friendly washrooms for the benefit of 2 handicapped war heroes at a cost of approximately £350 each.

In addition smaller donations were made to number of children for Educational means whose father is either disabled or killed as a result of the war.

As of the end of the financial year 2010/2011 a total of £5,203 funds retained in the Charity's bank account.

Every possible measure has been taken by the Trustees of the charity to minimise the administrative costs and other operational costs to the charity to a minimum. It is our pleasure to state that such costs are nil in this financial year.

Charity Trustees would like to thank and extend their warmest gratitude to everyone who supported the charity and its causes in numerous ways.
