Trustees' Report 2015/2016

Trustees of the Ranaviru Fund have the pleasure of producing this report for the Financial Year 2015-2016.

A total of £3,677 carried forward from the financial year 2014/2015. A total of £5,995 received as donations during this year with an addition of £2 received as bank interest. During the financial year the Charity has invested £5,246 in charitable activities.

Charity has spent £2,016.80 hosting the Sri Lankan New Year community event in April 2015 as a commitment to the local community. Funds required were raised with the support from community and also any balance from the raised funds after the above expenses were added to the reserve.

In July 2015, Charity has paid £207.00 to Verbalise Ltd to provide 9 Talking Watches for the benefit of visually impaired personnel. These watches were sent to Sri Lanka for the benefit of visually impaired soldiers.

A sum of £585.00 was raised in support for the 'Legal Aid' appeal for the benefits of soldiers who needed Legal assistance. This amount has been donated to the local campaign group in Sri Lanka that was campaigning for the appeal.

Charity has involved with providing financial assistance for the benefit of a cancer patient, who is the wife of a disabled soldier. It was our privilege to provide financial assistance through the funds we raised specifically for the cause to provide 2 injections to the patient. A total of £2,417.36 was paid directly to the supplier of the prescribed injection.

At the end of the financial year 2015/2016 a total of £4,428 retained in the Charity's bank account.

Every possible measure has been taken by the Trustees of the charity to minimise the administrative costs and other operational costs. It is our pleasure to state that such costs are nil in this financial year as well.

Charity Trustees would like to thank and extend their warmest gratitude to everyone who supported the charity and its causes in numerous ways.
